Membership Dues and Billing

All ACEC of Tennessee (ACEC of TN) members must also be members of the American Council of Engineering Companies (ACEC) through the firm's main office. Dues for both ACEC of TN and ACEC membership are based on the total number of full time employees of the firm.

- New firms may be eligible to receive a substantial discount in dues under the New Member Incentive Program. For information about eligibility and dues, please contact Judy Logue.
- ACEC of TN membership dues are based on the number of employees in Tennessee; for information about the cost of membership, please contact Judy Logue.
- ACEC bills their dues directly to firms having offices in more than one state.
- ACEC of TN bills for ACEC and ACEC of TN dues if the firm is located only in Tennessee.
- ACEC and ACEC of TN dues are billed quarterly and are calculated when a firm joins and annually every July.
- Each spring firms are sent a Membership Certification Update Form to return to ACEC of TN with any changes in employee number, officers, etc. If firms do not return the requested information, they will continue to be billed based on the last reported number of employees.
